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**STIPULATED SURRENDER OF
LICENSE AND ORDER**

17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
18 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

19 PARTIES

20 1. Susan Saylor (Complainant) is the Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural Pest
21 Control Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in this
22 matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Anahita S. Crawford,
23 Deputy Attorney General.

24 2. Bobby Joe Maddox (Respondent) is representing himself in this proceeding and has
25 chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.

26 3. On or about August 20, 2001, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Field
27 Representative License No. FR 33758 to Bobby Joe Maddox (Respondent). The Field
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1 Representative License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in
2 Accusation No. 2016-23 and will expire on June 30, 2016, unless renewed.

3 JURISDICTION

4 4. Accusation No. 2016-23 was filed before the Structural Pest Control Board (Board),
5 Department of Consumer Affairs, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation
6 and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on November
7 13, 2015. Respondent did not file a Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation but verbally
8 requested a stipulated settlement. A copy of Accusation No. 2016-23 is attached as Exhibit A and
9 incorporated by reference.

10 ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

11 5. Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in
12 Accusation No. 2016-23. Respondent also has carefully read, and understands the effects of this
13 Stipulated Surrender of License and Order.

14 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a
15 hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel, at
16 his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to
17 present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel
18 the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and
19 court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California
20 Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.

21 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and
22 every right set forth above.

23 CULPABILITY

24 8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation
25 No. 2016-23, agrees that cause exists for discipline and hereby surrenders his Field
26 Representative License No. FR 33758 for the Board's formal acceptance.

27 9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue
28 an order accepting the surrender of his Field Representative License without further process.

1 Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of
2 Respondent's license history with the Structural Pest Control Board.

3 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Field Representative in California
4 as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.

5 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board his pocket license and, if one was
6 issued, his wall certificate on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.

7 4. If Respondent ever files an application for licensure or a petition for reinstatement in
8 the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a petition for reinstatement. Respondent must
9 comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for reinstatement of a revoked license in
10 effect at the time the petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in
11 Accusation No. 2016-23 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when
12 the Board determines whether to grant or deny the petition.

13 5. Respondent shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the
14 amount of \$1,255.00 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

15 ACCEPTANCE

16 I have carefully read the Stipulated Surrender of License and Order. I understand the
17 stipulation and the effect it will have on my Field Representative License. I enter into this
18 Stipulated Surrender of License and Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to
19 be bound by the Decision and Order of the Structural Pest Control Board.
