22	1. Susan Saylor (Complainant) brings	this Accusation solely in her official capacity as
23	the Interim Registrar/Executive Officer of the St	tructural Pest Control Board, Department of
24	Pesticide Regulation.	
25	2. On or about September 18, 2006, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Field	
26	Representative License Number FR 40746 in Branch 2 to Matthew Carlton Villa, owner of Magik	
27	Exterminating (Respondent). The Field Representative License was in full force and effect at all	
28	times relevant to the charges brought herein and	will expire on June 30, 2015, unless renewed.

1	3. On or about December 15, 2005, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Applicator	
2	License Number RA 44916 in Branch 2 and 3 to Matthew Carlton Villa, owner of Magik	
3	Exterminating (Respondent). The Applicator License was in full force and effect at all times	
4	relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on December 15, 2014, unless renewed.	
5	4. On or about November 15, 2010, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Company	
6	Registration Certificate Number PR 6178 in Branch 2 to Magik Exterminating, with Matthew	
7	Carlton Villa as 51% owner (Respondent). The Company Registration Certificate was suspended	
8	on February 8, 2011 and cancelled in January of 2012. The Company Registration Certificate	
9	was cancelled at all times relevant to the charges brought herein.	
10	JURISDICTION	
11	5. This Accusation is brought before the Structural Pest Control Board (Board),	
12	Department of Pesticide Regulation, under the authority of the following laws. All section	
13	references are to the Business and Professions Code (Code) unless otherwise indicated.	
14	6. Section 8620 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may suspend or	
15	revoke a license when it finds that the holder, while a licensee or applicant, has committed any	
16	acts or omissions constituting cause for disciplinary action or in lieu of a suspension may assess a	
17	civil penalty.	
18	7. Section 8625 of the Code states:	
19	The lapsing or suspension of a license or company registration by	
20	operation of law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of a license or company registration shall not deprive the	
21	board of jurisdiction to proceed with any investigation of or action or disciplinary proceeding against such licensee or company, or to render a	
22	decision suspending or revoking such license or registration.	
23	8. Section 8654 of the Code states:	
24	Any individual who has been denied a license for any of the reasons specified in Section 8568, or who has had his or her license revoked, or whose	
25	license is under suspension, or who has been a member, officer, director, associate,	
26	was under suspension, or who has been a member, officer, director, associate, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of any partnership, corporation, firm, or association whose application for a company registration has been denied for any of the reasons specified in Section 8568, or whose company registration has been revoked as a result of disciplinary action, or whose company

28	registration is under suspension, and while acting as such member, officer,

director, associate, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee had knowledge of or participated in any of the prohibited acts for which the license or registration was denied, suspended or revoked, shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of a registered company, and the employment, election or association of such person by a registered company is a ground for disciplinary action.

### STATUTORY PROVISIONS

9. Section 8505 of the Code states:

'Structural pest control' and "pest control" as used in this chapter are synonymous. Except as provided in Section 8555 and elsewhere in this chapter, it is, with respect to household pests and wood destroying pests or organisms, or such other pests which may invade households or other structures, including railroad cars, ships, docks, trucks, airplanes, or the contents thereof, the engaging in, offering to engage in, advertising for, soliciting, or the performance of, any of the following: identification of infestations or infections; the making of an inspection or inspections for the purpose of identifying or attempting to identify infestations or infections of household or other structures by such pests or organisms; the making of inspection reports, recommendations, estimates, and bids, whether oral or written, with respect to such infestations or infections; and the making of contracts, or the submitting of bids for, or the performance of any work including the making of structural repairs or replacements, or the use of insecticides, pesticides, rodenticides, fumigants, or allied chemicals or substances, or mechanical devices for the purpose of eliminating, exterminating, controlling or preventing infestations or infections of such pests, or organisms.

'Household pests' are defined for the purpose of this chapter as those pests other than wood destroying pests or organisms, which invade households and other structures, including, but not limited to, rodents, vermin and insects.

10. Section 8506.1 of the Code states:

A 'registered company' is any sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or other organization or any combination thereof that is registered with the Structural Pest Control Board to engage in the practice of structural pest control.

A registered company may secure structural pest control work, submit bids, or otherwise contract for pest control work. A registered company may employ licensed field representatives and licensed operators to identify infestations or infections, make inspections, and represent the company in the securing of pest control work. A registered company may hire or employ individuals who are not licensed under this chapter to perform work on contracts covering wood-destroying organisms only after an operator or field representative has fully completed the negotiation or signing of the contract covering a given job.

1	A registered company may hire and use individuals who are not licensed under this chapter on service contracts already established.	
3.	11. Section 8507 of the Code states:	
4	(a) 'Structural pest control field representative' is any individual who is	
5	licensed by the board to secure structural pest control work, identify infestations or infections, make inspections, submit bids for or otherwise contract, in behalf of a registered company.

7	A pest control field representative shall not contract for pest control work or perform pest control work in his or her own behalf.	
8	(b) As used in this chapter, 'field representative' refers to 'structural pest control field representative.'	
10	12. Section 8507.1 of the Code states:	
11	(a) 'Structural pest control applicator' is any individual who is licensed	
12	by the board to apply a pesticide, rodenticide, or allied chemicals or substances for the purpose of eliminating, exterminating, controlling, or

14	A structural pest control applicator shall not contract for pest control work or perform pest control work in his or her own behalf.

16	(b) As used in this chapter, "applicator" refers to 'structural pest control applicator.'

4	(d) It is also unlawful for any unlicensed individual to offer any opinion, or to make any recommendations, concerning the need for structural pest control work in general, or in connection with a particular structure.	
5	(e) It is unlawful for any firm, sole proprietorship, partnership,	
6 7	corporation, association, or other organization or combination thereof to engage or offer to engage in the practice of structural pest control, unless registered in accordance with Article 6 (commencing with Section 8610).	
8	15. Section 8552 of the Code states:	
9	It is unlawful for any person to advertise or represent in any manner	
10	that any pest control work, in whole or in part, has been done upon any structure, unless the work has been performed by a company registered under this chapter.

12	16. Section 8610 of the Code states:	
13	(a) Every company that engages in the practice of structural pest	
14	control, as a sole proprietorship, partnership, corporation, or other organization or any combination thereof, shall be registered with the	
15	Structural Pest Control Board.

18	Failure to comply with the provisions of this chapter, or any rule or	
19	regulation adopted by the board, or the furnishing of a report of inspection without the making of a bona fide inspection of the premises for

21	ground for disciplinary action.	
22	COST RECOVERY	
23	18. Section 125.3 of the Code provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the	
24	administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations o	
25	the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and	
26	enforcement of the case, with failure of the licentiate to comply subjecting the license to not being	
27	renewed or reinstated. If a case settles, recovery of investigation and enforcement costs may be	
28	included in a stipulated settlement.

FACTS

19. The Structural Pest Control Board is empowered to issue Company Registration Certificates in Branch 2. A Company Registration Certificate in Branch 2 is a general pest control registration allowing a company to identify general pests, make recommendations for treatment, apply pesticides, advertise pest control services and enter into contracts for pest eradication. A Company Registration Certificate is required to operate a pest control business.

20. Respondent held a Company Registration Certificate beginning in 2010 under the
company name Magik Exterminating (Magik). Respondent was the majority owner of Magik but
not a qualifying manager. The Board suspended Magik's Company Registration Certificate in
February of 2011 when the qualifying manager dissociated from the company. In October of
2011, the Board issued a further suspension of Magik's Company Registration Certificate based
on the lapsing of Magik's liability insurance coverage.

21. On or about January 30, 2012, per Respondent's written request, Magik's Company Registration Certificate status was cancelled.

15 22. Beginning on or about June 2012 through January of 2013, Respondent used the
16 company name "Magik Termite and Pest Exterminating" to advertise for work, enter into pest
17 control contracts, make service agreements and apply pesticide, despite not having a current
18 Company Registration Certificate or insurance coverage.

19 23. The company Registration for Magik Exterminating has never been reactivated since
20 its initial suspension in February of 2011.

## FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

# (Unlicensed Practice of Structural Pest Control)

24. Respondent's Company Registration Certificate, Field Representative License and
Applicator License are subject to disciplinary action under Code section 8641, for violations of
Code sections 8506.1, 8550 and 8610 in that between June 2012 and January 2013, he engaged in
the practice of structural pest control without a valid Company Registration Certificate, as set
forth in paragraphs 19 through 23 above, which are incorporated herein by reference.

### SECOND CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE 1 (Acting Outside the Capacity of a Field Representative) 2 Respondent's Field Representative License is subject to disciplinary action under 25. 3 Code sections 8641, for violation of Code section 8507 subsection (a), in that between June 2012 4 and January 2013, he contracted for pest control work on his own behalf without a Company 5 Registration Certificate, as set forth in paragraphs 19 through 23 above, which are incorporated 6 herein by reference. 7 THIRD CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE 8 (Advertising Without a License) 9 Respondent's Company Registration Certificate, Field Representative License and 26. 10 Applicator License are subject to disciplinary action under Code section 8641, for violation of 11 Code section 8552, in that between June 2012 and January 2013, Respondent advertised for 12 structural pest control work without a proper Company Registration Certificate, as set forth in 13 paragraphs 19 through 23 above, which are incorporated herein by reference. 14 **OTHER MATTERS** 15 Pursuant to section 8654 of the Code, if discipline is imposed on Field 27. 16 Representative License No. FR 40746 and/or Applicator License Number RA 44916 issued to 17 Respondent, Matthew Carlton Villa, he shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, 18 associate, partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee for any registered 19 company during the time the discipline is imposed, and any registered company which elects, 20associates, or employees Respondent as a responsible managing employee, shall be subject to 21 disciplinary action. 22 PRAYER 23 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged, 24 and that following the hearing, the Structural Pest Control Board issue a decision: 25Revoking or suspending Company Registration Certificate Number PR 6178, issued 1. 2.6 to Magik Exterminating with Matthew Carlton Villa, owner of Magik Exterminating. 27 /// 28 7

Revoking or suspending Field Representative License Number FR 40746, issued to 2. Matthew Carlton Villa, owner of Magik Exterminating; 2

Revoking or suspending Applicator License Number RA 44916, issued to Matthew 3. Carlton Villa, owner of Magik Exterminating;

Prohibiting Respondent from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, 4. qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of a registered company;

Ordering Matthew Carlton Villa to pay the Structural Pest Control Board the 5. reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3;
