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17	IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-					
18	entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:					
19	<u>PARTIES</u>					
20	1. Susan Saylor (Complainant) is the Interim Registrar/Executive Officer of the					
21	Structural Pest Control Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is					
22	represented in this matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by					
23	Gregory J. Salute, Supervising Deputy Attorney General.					
24	2. Respondent Ronald A. Lopez (Respondent) is representing himself in this proceeding					
25	and has chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.					
26	3. On or about January 20, 2009, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Field					
27	Representative's License No. FR 43968 to Ronald A. Lopez (Respondent). The Field					
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Representative's License was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 2013-20 and will expire on June 30, 2014, unless renewed.

JURISDICTION |

- 4. Accusation No. 2013-20 was filed before the Structural Pest Control Board (Board), Department of Pesticide Regulation, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on November 6, 2012. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation.
- 5. A copy of Accusation No. 2013-20 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 6. Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 2013-20. Respondent has also carefully read, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order.
- 7. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel at his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 8. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

CULPABILITY

- 9. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 2013-20.
- 10. Respondent agrees that his Field Representative's License is subject to discipline and he agrees to be bound by the Board's probationary terms as set forth in the Disciplinary Order below.

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CIRCUMSTANCES IN MITIGATION

11. Respondent Ronald A. Lopez has never been the subject of any disciplinary action. He is admitting responsibility at an early stage in the proceedings.

CONTINGENCY

- 12. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Structural Pest Control Board. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Structural Pest Control Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and settlement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 13. The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 14. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be an integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement. It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions, negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.
- 15. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Disciplinary Order:

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DISCIPLINARY ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Field Representative's License No. FR 43968 issued to Respondent Ronald A. Lopez (Respondent) is revoked. However, the revocation is stayed and Respondent is placed on probation for three (3) years on the following terms and conditions:

- 1. **Obey All Laws.** Respondent shall obey all federal, state and local laws and all rules and regulations relating to the practice of structural pest control.
- 2. **Quarterly Reports.** Respondent shall file quarterly reports with the Board during the period of probation.
- 3. **Tolling of Probation.** Should Respondent leave California to reside outside this state, Respondent must notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of residency or practice outside the state shall not apply to reduction of the probationary period.
- 4. **Notice to Employers.** Respondent shall notify all present and prospective employers of the decision in Case No. 2013-20 and the terms, conditions and restriction imposed on Respondent by said decision.

Within 30 days of the effective date of this decision, and within 15 days of Respondent undertaking new employment, Respondent shall cause his/her employer to report to the Board in writing acknowledging the employer has read the decision in Case No. 2013-20.

- 5. **Notice to Employees.** Respondent shall, upon or before the effective date of this decision, post or circulate a notice to all employees involved in structural pest control operations which accurately recite the terms and conditions of probation. Respondent shall be responsible for said notice being immediately available to said employees. "Employees" as used in this provision includes all full-time, part-time, temporary and relief employees and independent contractors employed or hired at any time during probation.
- 6. **Completion of Probation.** Upon successful completion of probation, Respondent's license/certificate will be fully restored.
- 7. Violation of Probation. Should Respondent violate probation in any respect, the Board, after giving Respondent notice and an opportunity to be heard, may revoke probation and carry out the disciplinary order which was stayed. If a petition to revoke probation is filed against

Respondent during probation, the Board shall have continuing jurisdiction until the matter is final, and the period of probation shall be extended until the matter is final.

- 8. Prohibited from Serving as Officer, Director, Associate, Partner or Qualifying Manager. Respondent is prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager or branch office manager of any registered company during the period that discipline is imposed on Field Representative's License No. FR 43968.
- 9. **No Interest In Any Registered Company.** Respondent shall not have any legal or beneficial interest in any company currently or hereinafter registered by the Board.
- 10. Civil Penalty. Respondent shall pay a civil penalty to the Board in the amount of \$1500.00. Upon request, Respondent shall be permitted to pay the civil penalty in a payment plan approved by the Board, with payments to be completed no later than six months prior to the end of the probation term. Probation shall not terminate until full payment has been made. Should any part of the civil penalty not be paid in accordance with the outlined payment schedule, Respondent shall be considered to be in violation of probation. Any order for payment of the civil penalty shall remain in effect whether or not probation is tolled. The filing of bankruptcy by the Respondent shall not relieve the Respondent of his responsibility to reimburse the Board for these costs.
- 11. Additional Licenses. Any additional license issued to Respondent by the Board (during the period that discipline is imposed on Field Representative's License No. FR 43968) shall also be placed on probation on the same terms and conditions as the current period of probation.
- 12. **Cost Recovery**. Respondent shall pay to the Board costs associated with its investigation and enforcement pursuant to Business and Professions Code Section 125.3 in the amount of \$1,122.50. Upon request, Respondent shall be permitted to pay these costs in a payment plan approved by the Board, with payments to be completed no later than six months prior to the end of the probation term. Probation shall not terminate until full payment has been made. Should any part of cost recovery not be paid in accordance with the outlined payment schedule, Respondent shall be considered to be in violation of probation. Any order for payment

of cost recovery shall remain in effect whether or not probation is tolled. The filing of bankruptcy by the Respondent shall not relieve the Respondent of his responsibility to reimburse the Board for these costs.

decision, Respondent shall provide proof to the Board of completion of 16 hours of continuing education courses approved by the Board, including eight (8) hours of Rules and Regulations, four (4) hours of technical in Branch 2, two (2) hours of Integrated Pest Management and two (2) hours of general. These hours cannot be used or counted towards renewal of Field Representative License No. FR 43968. Should Respondent fail to submit proof to the Board of completion of the 16 hours of continuing education within the 60 day time period, it shall be considered a violation of probation and Field Representative License No. FR 43968 shall be suspended until proof is provided to the Board of satisfaction of this condition.

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>

I have carefully read the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Field Representative's License. I enter into this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Structural Pest Control Board.
