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22	FINDINGS OF FACT	
23	1. On or about October 14, 2014, Complainant Susan Saylor, in her official capacity as	
24	the Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural Pest Control Board, Department of Consumer	
25	Affairs, filed Accusation No. 2015-20 against Jeffrey W. Enos (Respondent) before the Structural	
26	Pest Control Board. (Accusation attached as Exhibit A.)	
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Applicator License/Field Representative License

- 2. On or about October 1, 2009, the Board issued Applicator License Number RA 50378, Branches 2 and 3, to Jeffrey W. Enos ("Respondent"), as an employee of Clark Pest Control. On or about February 22, 2010, the applicator's license was downgraded to include Branch 3 only, due to the issuance of a Branch 2 field representative license. On or about November 11, 2010, Respondent left the employ of Clark Pest Control. The applicator's license was cancelled from the Board's files on October 1, 2012.
- 3. On or about February 22, 2010, the Board issued Field Representative License No. FR 45206, Branch 2, to Respondent, as an employee of Clark Pest Control. On or about November 11, 2010, Respondent left the employ of Clark Pest Control. On or about March 21, 2012, Respondent's field representative license reflected employment with Earth Guard Pest Management Services. On or about August 26, 2013, Respondent's field representative license reflected employment with Applied Pest Management, Inc. On or about June 24, 2014, the field representative license was suspended pursuant to Family Code section 17520. Respondent's field representative license is currently in effect and was in effect at all times relevant to the charges brought herein. The field representative license will expire on June 30, 2015, unless renewed.
- 4. On or about October 23, 2014, Respondent was served by certified mail and regular mail with copies of the Accusation No. 2015-20, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondent's address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondent's address of record was and is:

- 5. On or about October 23, 2014, Respondent was also served by certified mail and regular mail with copies of the Accusation No. 2015-20, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5,

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- 13. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds Respondent is in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this matter, as well as taking official notice of all the investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained therein on file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation No. 2015-20, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 2015-20, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.
- 14. Taking official notice of its own internal records, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3, it is hereby determined that the reasonable costs for Investigation and Enforcement is \$1,420.00 as of March 18, 2015.

DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

- 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Jeffrey W. Enos has subjected his Field Representative License No. FR 45206 to discipline.
 - 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.
- 3. The Structural Pest Control Board is authorized to revoke Respondent's Field Representative License based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this case:
- a. Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 8641, in that he failed to comply with Business and Professions Code Section 8593 and California Code of Regulations, title 16, section 1950(a) by failing to verify that he completed courses of continuing education in pest control approved by the Board. Specifically, Respondent failed to submit copies of his continuing education certificates for the renewal period July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2012, as requested by the Board representative.

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ORDER

IT IS SO ORDERED that Field Representative License No. FR 45206, heretofore issued to Respondent Jeffrey W. Enos, is revoked.

Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

This Decision shall become effective on June 3, 2015.
