STIPULATION FOR A PROBATIONARY LICENSE

Field Representative License Branch 2

Joel Garcia, applicant for a structural pest control field representative license Branch 2 (hereinafter Applicant), and Susan Saylor, Interim Registrar/Executive Officer, Structural Pest Control Board (Board), hereby stipulate as follows:

1. This Applicant is not presently licensed as a structural pest control applicator, field representative or operator with the Board in the State of California.

2. On or about May 23, 2013, the Board received an Application for Structural Pest Control Field Representative License Branch 2 from Joel Garcia.

3. Applicant was convicted on November 16, 1993 in San Diego Municipal Court of Health and Safety Code 11377(a), misdemeanor: possess of a controlled substance. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years probation and 31 days in jail.

4. Applicant was convicted on July 18, 1994 in San Diego Municipal Court of Penal Code 242/243(a), misdemeanor: battery. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years probation, restitution and work program.

5. Applicant was convicted on October 28, 1996 in San Diego Municipal Court of Penal Code 242/243(a), misdemeanor: battery on person. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years probation and pay a fine of \$200.

6. Applicant was convicted on December 21, 2000 in San Diego Superior Court of Vehicle Code 14601.1(a), misdemeanor: driving while license is suspended. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years probation.

7. Applicant was convicted on May 17, 2001 in San Diego Superior Court of Vehicle Code 23152(b), misdemeanor: DUI/0.08 percent and VC 14601.1(a), misdemeanor: driving while license is suspended. Respondent was sentenced to 3 years probation and work program.

8. Applicant was convicted on April 6, 2004 in Federal Court of: 846 and 841(a)(1): conspiracy to distribute methamphetamine. The Applicant was sentenced to 10 years in prison. Respondent was released on November 20, 2009 and is on 5 years supervised release.

<u>ORDER</u>

Applicant, Joel Garcia is hereby granted a probationary Field Representative License Branch 2. The license is placed on three (3) years probation upon the following terms and conditions:

- 1. Compliance with all provisions of the Business and Professions Code, Division 3, Chapter 14, Structural Pest Control Act, and California Code of Regulations, Title 16, Professional and Vocational Regulations, Division 19. Applicant shall obey all laws and rules relating to the practice of structural pest control.
- 2. Applicant shall obey all Local, State and Federal laws.
- 3. Quarterly Reports. Applicant shall file quarterly reports with the Board during the period of probation.
- 4. **Tolling of Probation**. Should Applicant leave California to reside outside this state, Applicant must notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of residency or practice outside the state shall not apply to reduction of the probationary period.
- 5. Notice to Employers. Applicant shall notify all present and prospective employers of the terms, conditions and restrictions imposed on Applicant by said Order. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Order, and within 15 days of Applicant undertaking new employment, Applicant shall cause his employer to report to the Board in writing acknowledging the employer has read the Order in this matter.
- 6. **Random Inspections.** Applicant shall reimburse the Board for one random inspection per quarter by the Board specialists during the period of probation not to exceed \$125 per inspection.
- 7. **Completion of Probation**. Upon successful completion of probation, Applicant's license will become fully restored.
- 8. Violation of Probation. Should Applicant violate probation in any respect, the Board, after giving Applicant notice and an opportunity to be heard, may revoke the probationary license.
- 9. **Biological Testing**. Applicant, at his expense, shall submit to any random biological fluid testing or a drug screening program which is acceptable to the Board. The length of time and frequency will be subject to approval by the Board. The results must be submitted directly by the testing agency to the Board. Failure to comply within the time specified or confirmed positive test shall be considered a violation of probation.

- 10. Prohibited from Serving as Officer, Director, Associate, Partner or Qualifying Manager. Applicant is prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager or branch office manager of any registered company, during the period that probation is imposed on the field representative license.
- 11. Future License. Should Applicant apply for any additional license during probation, the Board shall issue the license, which shall be immediately placed on probation for the same duration and under the same terms and conditions as set forth in this Order.

ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Order. I understand the Order and the effect it will have on my Field Representative's license. I enter into this Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Order of the Board.
