**STIPULATION FOR A
PROBATIONARY LICENSE**

Andy Bill Shubin, applicant for a structural pest control Field Representative License Branches 2 and 3 (hereinafter Applicant), and Susan Saylor, Registrar/Executive Officer, Structural Pest Control Board (Board), hereby stipulate as follows:

1. This Applicant is not presently licensed as a structural pest control applicator, field representative or operator with the Board in the State of California.
2. On or about June 25, 2015, the Board received an Application for Structural Pest Control Field Representative License Branches 2 and 3 from Andy Shubin.
3. Applicant was convicted on August 1, 2012 in Fresno Superior Court of Penal Code 530.5(A), misdemeanor: use other's ID or credit. Applicant was sentenced to 3 years conditional sentence probation and 60 days in Fresno County Jail. The circumstances surrounding the conviction are: Applicant was using his stepdaughter's credit card for business expenses. The business went bankrupt and Mr. Shubin was unable to cover the credit card bills. Applicant's stepdaughter filed charges with the District Attorney's office for illegal use of her credit card.

ORDER

Applicant, Andy Bill Shubin is hereby granted a probationary Field Representative License Branches 2 and 3. The license is placed on three (3) years probation upon the following terms and conditions:

1. **Obey All Laws.** Applicant shall obey all Local, State and Federal laws and all laws and rules relating to the practice of structural pest control.
2. **Quarterly Reports.** Applicant shall file quarterly reports with the Board during the period of probation.
3. **Tolling of Probation.** Should Applicant leave California to reside outside this state, Applicant must notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of residency or practice outside the state shall not apply to reduction of the probationary period.


4. **Notice to Employers.** Applicant shall notify all present and prospective employers of the terms, conditions and restrictions imposed on Applicant by said Order. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Order, and within 15 days of Applicant undertaking new employment, Applicant shall cause his employer to report to the Board in writing acknowledging the employer has read the Order in this matter.
5. **Completion of Probation.** Upon successful completion of probation, Applicant's license will become fully restored.
6. **Violation of Probation.** Should Applicant violate probation in any respect, the Board, after giving Applicant notice and an opportunity to be heard, may revoke the probationary license.
7. **Correspondence Course.** Applicant shall complete within six (6) months of the effective date of this Order, four (4) hours of a Board approved business ethics course. These hours cannot be used towards renewal of license.
8. **Prohibited from Serving as Officer, Director, Associate, Partner or Qualifying Manager.** Applicant is prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager or branch office manager of any registered company, during the period that probation is imposed on the field representative license.

ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Order. I understand the Order and the effect it will have on my Field Representative's license. I enter into this Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Order of the Board.


