## DEFAULT DECISION AND ORDER

[Gov. Code, §11520]

## FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about April 11, 2012, Complainant William H. Douglas, in his official capacity as the Interim Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural Pest Control Board, Department of Pesticide Regulation, filed Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation No. 2012-49 against Ariston Termite Company with Mayra Leon, as Owner (Respondent Ariston Termite) and Samuel

Rodriguez (Respondents Rodriguez) before the Structural Pest Control Board. (Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation attached as **Exhibit A**.)

- 2. On or about March 4, 2010, the Board issued Company Registration Certificate Number PR 6010 in Branch 3 to Ariston Termite Company with Mayra Leon as owner ("Respondents Ariston Termite") and Samuel Rodriguez ("Respondents Rodriguez"), as qualifying manager.
- 3. On or about July 30, 2003, the Board issued Operator's License Number OPR 10765 in Branch 3 to Respondents Rodriguez. The license is currently inactive and will expire on June 30, 2015, unless renewed.
- 4. On or about May 21, 2012, Respondents was served by Certified and First Class Mail copies of the Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation No. 2012-49, Statement to Respondent, Notice of Defense, Request for Discovery, and Discovery Statutes (Government Code sections 11507.5, 11507.6, and 11507.7) at Respondents' address of record which, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 136, is required to be reported and maintained with the Board. Respondent Ariston Termite's address of record was and is: Post Office Box 1489, Paramount, CA 90723. Respondent Rodriguez's address of record was Post Office Box 1489, Paramount, CA 90723 and is currently 2990 N. Orange Avenue, Rialto, CA 92377. Respondent Rodriguez disassociated as qualifying manager of Ariston Termite Company in or about October 2012.
- 5. Service of the Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation was effective as a matter of law under the provisions of Government Code section 11505, subdivision (c) and/or Business & Professions Code section 124.
- 6. On or about May 22, 2012, Respondents signed and returned a Notice of Defense, requesting a hearing in this matter. A Notice of Hearing was served by mail at Respondents' address of record and it informed them that an administrative hearing in this matter was scheduled for November 28, 2012. Respondents failed to appear at that hearing.
  - 7. Government Code section 11506 states, in pertinent part:
    - (c) The Respondents shall be entitled to a hearing on the merits if the

Respondents files a notice of defense, and the notice shall be deemed a specific denial of all parts of the accusation not expressly admitted. Failure to file a notice of defense shall constitute a waiver of Respondents' right to a hearing, but the agency in its discretion may nevertheless grant a hearing.

- 8. California Government Code section 11520 states, in pertinent part:
- (a) If the Respondents either fails to file a notice of defense or to appear at the hearing, the agency may take action based upon the Respondents' express admissions or upon other evidence and affidavits may be used as evidence without any notice to Respondents.
- 9. Pursuant to its authority under Government Code section 11520, the Board finds Respondents are in default. The Board will take action without further hearing and, based on the relevant evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this matter, as well as taking official notice of all the investigatory reports, exhibits and statements contained therein on file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation No. 2012-49, finds that the charges and allegations in the Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation No. 2012-49, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by clear and convincing evidence.
- 10. Taking official notice of its own internal records, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3, it is hereby determined that the reasonable costs for Investigation and Enforcement is \$5,785.00 as of November 26, 2012.

## **DETERMINATION OF ISSUES**

- 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Ariston Termite has subjected her Company Registration Certificate No. PR 6010 and Respondent Rodriguez has subjected his Operator's License No. OPR 10765, Branch 3, to discipline.
  - 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.
- 3. The Structural Pest Control Board is authorized to revoke Respondent Ariston
  Termite's Company Registration Certificate and Respondent Rodriguez's Operator's License
  based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation,
  which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default Decision Evidence Packet in this
  case:
