**STIPULATED SETTLEMENT AND
DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

17 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties to the above-
18 entitled proceedings that the following matters are true:

19 PARTIES

20 1. Susan Saylor ("Complainant") is the Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural
21 Pest Control Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is represented in
22 this matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General of the State of California, by Terrence M.
23 Mason, Deputy Attorney General.

24 2. Larry Charles Holmes, Jr. ("Respondent") is representing himself in this proceeding
25 and has chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.

26 3. On or about August 25, 1987, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Operator's
27 License No. OPR 7752 to Respondent Larry Charles Holmes, Jr. The Operator's License expired
28 on June 30, 2014, and has not been renewed.

1 Pest Control Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and
2 settlement, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation,
3 Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the
4 stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this
5 stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order shall be of
6 no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between
7 the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this
8 matter.

9 12. The parties understand and agree that Portable Document Format (PDF) and facsimile
10 copies of this Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order, including Portable Document Format
11 (PDF) and facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.

12 13. This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order is intended by the parties to be an
13 integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement.
14 It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions,
15 negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary
16 Order may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a
17 writing executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

18 14. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
19 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following
20 Disciplinary Order:

21 **DISCIPLINARY ORDER**

22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Operator's License No. OPR 7752 issued to Respondent
23 Larry Charles Holmes, Jr. is revoked.

24 Larry Charles Holmes, Jr. shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate,
25 partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of any registered company
26 during the period that discipline is imposed on Operator License No. OPR 7752 issued to him.

27 For purposes of settlement of this matter, the parties agree and understand that the Board
28 will waive its right to recover its reasonable costs of investigation and enforcement of the case.

1 However, should Respondent ever seek reinstatement of his Operator's License or the issuance of
2 any other license from the Board, the parties agree and understand that Respondent shall
3 reimburse the costs of investigation and enforcement of Accusation No. 2015-38 in the amount of
4 \$2,782.50 as a precondition to any such license reinstatement/ issuance.

5 ACCEPTANCE

6 I have carefully read the Stipulated Settlement and Disciplinary Order. I understand the
7 stipulation and the effect it will have on my Operator's License. I enter into this Stipulated
8 Settlement and Disciplinary Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be
9 bound by the Decision and Order of the Structural Pest Control Board.
