FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On or about May 7, 2015, Complainant Susan Saylor, in her official capacity as the Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural Pest Control Board, Department of Consumer Affairs, filed Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation No. 2015-53 against Foxx Termite, Inc., Alonzo Sillas (Respondent) before the Structural Pest Control Board. (Accusation and Petition to Revoke Probation attached as Exhibit A.)

1 file at the Board's offices regarding the allegations contained in Accusation and Petition to
2 Revoke Probation No. 2015-53, finds that the charges and allegations in Accusation and Petition
3 to Revoke Probation No. 2015-53, are separately and severally, found to be true and correct by
4 clear and convincing evidence.

5 8. Taking official notice of its own internal records, pursuant to Business and
6 Professions Code section 125.3, it is hereby determined that the reasonable costs for Investigation
7 and Enforcement is \$2,445.00 as of August 26, 2015.

8 9 DETERMINATION OF ISSUES

10 1. Based on the foregoing findings of fact, Respondent Foxx Termite, Inc., Alonzo
11 Sillas has subjected its Company Registration Certificate No. PR 6265 to discipline.

12 2. The agency has jurisdiction to adjudicate this case by default.

13 3. The Structural Pest Control Board is authorized to revoke Respondent's Company
14 Registration Certificate based upon the following violations alleged in the Accusation and
15 Petition to Revoke Probation which are supported by the evidence contained in the Default
16 Decision Evidence Packet in this case:

17 Accusation

18 a. Failure to File Wood Destroying Organism Activities Report in violation of §§
19 8516(b) and 8518 in conjunction with Cal. Code of Regs. Title 16 § 1996.3(a);

20 b. Gross Negligence in violation of § 8642;

21 c. Failure to Maintain Insurance Policy in violation of §§ 8691, 8692 and 8695;

22 d. Failure to Maintain Indemnity Bond in violation of § 8697;

23 e. Failure to Maintain Restoration Bond in violation of § 8697.3.

24 Petition to Revoke

25 a. Failure to Obey All Laws in violation of Probation Condition No. 1;

26 b. Failure to Maintain a Bond Requirement in violation of Probation Condition No. 15;

27 c. Failure to File a Surety Bond in violation of Condition No. 16;

28 d. Failure to File WDO Activities in violation of Condition No. 17;

- 1 e. Failure to Pay Citation and Fines in violation of Condition No. 18;
2 f. Failure to Pay Cost Recovery in the amount of \$9,315.14 in violation of Condition
3 No. 13.


5 **ORDER**

6 IT IS SO ORDERED that Company Registration Certificate No. PR 6265, heretofore issued
7 to Respondent Foxx Termite, Inc., Alonzo Sillas, is revoked.

8 Pursuant to Government Code section 11520, subdivision (c), Respondent may serve a
9 written motion requesting that the Decision be vacated and stating the grounds relied on within
10 seven (7) days after service of the Decision on Respondent. The agency in its discretion may
11 vacate the Decision and grant a hearing on a showing of good cause, as defined in the statute.

12 This Decision shall become effective on November 12, 2015.
