licensee or applicant, has committed any acts or omissions constituting cause for disciplinary 1 action or in lieu of a suspension may assess a civil penalty. 2 4. Code section 8625 states: 3 4 The lapsing or suspension of a license or company registration by operation of law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of a license or company registration shall not deprive the board of 5 jurisdiction to proceed with any investigation of or action or disciplinary proceeding 6 against such licensee or company, or to render a decision suspending or revoking such license or registration. 7 5. Code section 8649 states: 8 9 Conviction of a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a structural pest control operator, field representative, applicator, or 10 registered company is a ground for disciplinary action. The certified record of conviction shall be conclusive evidence thereof. 11 COST RECOVERY 12 6. Code section 125.3 states, in pertinent part, that a Board may request the 13 administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of 14 the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and 15 enforcement of the case. 16 CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE 17 (Criminal Conviction) 18 7. Respondent's applicator license is subject to disciplinary action under Code section 19 8649, in that on March 2, 2011, in the Superior Court, County of Los Angeles, California, in the 20 21 matter entitled People vs. John Enrique Marin, 2010, Case No. BA378829, Respondent was 22 convicted by the Court following his plea of guilty to a violation of Penal Code section 487, subdivision (a) (grand theft by embezzlement), felony. The circumstances of the crime are that 23 between July 16, 2009, and January 22, 2010, while employed by Frank and Sons Exterminators, 24 Respondent took money and personal property exceeding \$400.
