| 17 | In the interest of a prompt and speedy resolution of this matter, consistent with the |
| 18 | public interest and the responsibility of the Structural Pest Control Board of the Department of |
| 19 | Consumer Affairs, the parties hereby agree to the following Stipulated Surrender of License and |
| 20 | Order which will be submitted to the Board for approval and adoption as the final disposition of |
| 21 | the Accusation. |
| 22 | <u>PARTIES</u> |
| 23 | 1. Kelli Okuma (Complainant) is the Registrar/Executive Officer of the |
| 24 | Structural Pest Control Board. She brought this action solely in her official capacity and is |
| 25 | represented in this matter by Edmund G. Brown Jr., Attorney General of the State of California, |
| 26 | by Karen L. Gordon, Deputy Attorney General. |
| 27 | 2. Gustavo Hurtado, Jr. (Respondent) is representing himself in this |
| 28 | proceeding and has chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel. |

3. On or about July 6, 2006, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Registered Applicator's License No. RA 45948 in Branches 2 & 3 to Gustavo Hurtado, Jr. (Respondent). The license was in full force and effect at all times relevant to the charges brought in Accusation No. 2009-29 and will expire on July 6, 2009, unless renewed.

JURISDICTION

4. Accusation No. 2009-29 was filed before the Structural Pest Control Board (Board), Department of Consumer Affairs, and is currently pending against Respondent. The Accusation and all other statutorily required documents were properly served on Respondent on December 4, 2008. Respondent timely filed his Notice of Defense contesting the Accusation. A copy of Accusation No. 2009-29 is attached as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

ADVISEMENT AND WAIVERS

- 5. Respondent has carefully read, and understands the charges and allegations in Accusation No. 2009-29. Respondent also has carefully read, and understands the effects of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order.
- 6. Respondent is fully aware of his legal rights in this matter, including the right to a hearing on the charges and allegations in the Accusation; the right to be represented by counsel, at his own expense; the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against him; the right to present evidence and to testify on his own behalf; the right to the issuance of subpoenas to compel the attendance of witnesses and the production of documents; the right to reconsideration and court review of an adverse decision; and all other rights accorded by the California Administrative Procedure Act and other applicable laws.
- 7. Respondent voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently waives and gives up each and every right set forth above.

CULPABILITY

8. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in Accusation No. 2009-29, agrees that cause exists for discipline and hereby surrenders his Registered Applicator's License for the Board's formal acceptance.

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9. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue an order accepting the surrender of his Registered Applicator's License without further process.

CONTINGENCY

- Board. Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Structural Pest Control Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation, Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this matter.
- 11. The parties understand and agree that facsimile copies of this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order, including facsimile signatures thereto, shall have the same force and effect as the originals.
- 12. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Registered Applicator's License No. RA 45948, issued to Respondent Gustavo Hurtado, Jr. is surrendered and accepted by the Structural Pest Control Board.

13. The surrender of Respondent's Registered Applicator's License and the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall become a part of Respondent's license history with the Board.

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- 14. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Registered Applicator in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.
- 15. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board both his wall license certificate and, if one was issued, pocket license on or before the effective date of the Decision and Order.
- 16. If he ever applies for licensure or petitions for reinstatement in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a new application for licensure. Respondent must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures for licensure in effect at the time the application or petition is filed, and all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 2009-29 shall be deemed to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Board determines whether to grant or deny the application or petition.
- 17. Should Respondent ever apply or reapply for a new license or certification, or petition for reinstatement of a license, by any other health care licensing agency in the State of California, all of the charges and allegations contained in Accusation No. 2009-29 shall be deemed to be true, correct, and admitted by Respondent for the purpose of any Statement of Issues or any other proceeding seeking to deny or restrict licensure.
- 18. Respondent shall pay the Board its costs of investigation and enforcement in the amount of \$909.75 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

<u>ACCEPTANCE</u>

I have carefully read the Stipulated Surrender of License and Order. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Registered Applicator's License. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Structural Pest Control Board.

Section 490 of the Code states:

A board may suspend or revoke a license on the ground that the licensee has been convicted of a crime, if the crime is substantially related to the qualifications, functions, or duties of the business or profession for which the license was issued. A conviction within the meaning of this section means a plea or verdict of guilty or a conviction following a plea of nole contendere. Any action which a board is permitted to take following the establishment of a conviction may be taken when the time for appeal has clapsed, or the judgment of conviction has been affirmed on appeal, or when an order granting probation is made suspending the imposition of sentence, irrespective of a subsequent order under the provisions of Section 1203.4 of the Penal Code.

5. Section 493 of the Code states, in pertinent part:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in a proceeding conducted by a board within the department pursuant to law to deny an application for a license or to suspend or revoke a license or otherwise take disciplinary action against a person who holds a license, upon the ground that the applicant or the licensee has been convicted of a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of the licensee in question, the record of conviction of the crime shall be conclusive evidence of the fact that the conviction occurred, but only of that fact, and the board may inquire into the circumstances surrounding the commission of the crime in order to fix the degree of discipline or to determine if the conviction is substantially related to the qualifications,

6. Business and Professions Code ("Code") section 8620 provides, in pentinent part, that the Board may suspend or revoke a license when it finds that the holder, while a licensee or applicant, has committed any acts or omissions constituting cause for disciplinary action or in lieu of a suspension may assess a civil penalty.

Code section 8649 states:

Conviction of a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a structural pest control operator, field representative, applicator, or registered company is a ground for disciplinary action. The certified record of conviction shall be conclusive evidence thereof.

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8. Code section 8654 states:

Any individual who has been denied a license for any of the reasons. specified in Section 8568, or who has had his or her license revoked, or whose license is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was under suspension, or who has been a member, officer, director, associate, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of any partnership. corporation, firm, or association whose application for a company registration has been denied for any of the reasons specified in Section 8568, or whose company registration has been revoked as a result of disciplinary action, or whose company registration is under suspension, and while acting as such member, officer, director, associate, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee had knowledge of or participated in any of the prohibited acts for which the license or registration was denied, suspended or revoked, shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of a registered company, and the employment, election or association of such person by a registered company is a ground for disciplinary action.

9. Code section 8655 states:

A plea or verdict of guilty or a conviction following a plea of nolo contendere made to a charge substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a structural pest control operator, field representative, applicator, or registered company is deemed to be a conviction withing the meaning of this article or Section 8568 of this chapter. The board may order the license or registration suspended or revoked, or may decline to issue a license, when the time for appeal has elapsed, or the judgment of conviction has been affirmed on appeal or when an order granting probation is made suspending the imposition of sentence, irrespective of a subsequent order under the provisions of Section 1203.4 of the Penal Code allowing the individual or registered company to withdraw a plea of guilty and to enter a plea of not guilty, or setting side the verdict of guilty, or dismissing the accusation, information or indictment.

Cost Recovery

10. Code section 125.3 states, in pertinent part, that a Board may request the administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of the case.

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CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE

(June 6, 2008 Criminal Conviction - Petty Theft on April 15, 2008)

crime are as follows:

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Respondent is subject to disciplinary action pursuant to Code sections 490, 493, and 8649 in that on or about June 6, 2008, in the criminal proceeding titled *People v. Gustavo Adolfo Hurtado, Jr.* (Super. Ct. San Diego County, 2008, Case No. C279821), Respondent pled guilty to Penal Code section 484 (petty-theff), a crime substantially related to the qualifications, functions, and duties of a registered applicator. The circumstances of the

- 12. On or about April 15, 2008, Respondent unlawfully stole, misappropriated, and fraudulently took property valued at less than \$400 from Home Depot, Lemon Grove, California.
- 13. Pursuant to the Plea Agreement, on or about June 10, 2008, Respondent was sentenced to three (3) years of probation, one (1) day in custody, fines, and ordered to stay away from Home Depot.

OTHER MATTERS

- 14. Code section 8620 provides, in pertinent part, that a respondent may request that a civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 be assessed in lieu of an actual suspension of 1 to 19 days, or not more than \$10,000 for an actual suspension of 20 to 45 days. Such request must be made at the time of the hearing and must be noted in the proposed decision. The proposed decision shall not provide that a civil penalty shall be imposed in lieu of a suspension.
- Applicator's License Number RA 45948, issued to Respondent Gustavo Adolfo Hurtado, Jr., Gustavo Adolfo Hurtado, Jr. shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee for any registered company during the time the discipline is imposed, and any registered company which employs, elects, or associates Gustavo Adolfo Hurtado, Jr. shall be subject to disciplinary action.
