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**STIPULATED SURRENDER OF
LICENSE AND ORDER**

18 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED AND AGREED by and between the parties in this
19 proceeding that the following matters are true:

20 PARTIES

21 1. Susan Saylor (Complainant) is the Interim Registrar/Executive Officer of the
22 Structural Pest Control Board, who maintains this action solely in her official capacity. William
23 H. Douglas was the former Interim Registrar/Executive Officer, who brought this action solely in
24 his official capacity. Both are represented in this matter by Kamala D. Harris, Attorney General
25 of the State of California, by Kent D. Harris, Deputy Attorney General.

26 2. Jason L. Bohannon (Respondent) is representing himself in this proceeding and has
27 chosen not to exercise his right to be represented by counsel.

1 CULPABILITY

2 9. Respondent admits the truth of each and every charge and allegation in First
3 Amended Accusation No. 2011-72(b), agrees that cause exists for discipline and hereby
4 surrenders his Field Representative's License No. FR 45160 and his Applicator License No. RA
5 48306 for the Board's formal acceptance.

6 10. Respondent understands that by signing this stipulation he enables the Board to issue
7 an order accepting the surrender of his Field Representative's License and Applicator License
8 without further process.

9 RESERVATION

10 11. The admissions made by Respondent herein are only for the purposes of this
11 proceeding, or any other proceedings in which the Structural Pest Control Board is involved, and
12 shall not be admissible in any other criminal or civil proceeding.

13 CONTINGENCY

14 12. This stipulation shall be subject to approval by the Structural Pest Control Board.
15 Respondent understands and agrees that counsel for Complainant and the staff of the Structural
16 Pest Control Board may communicate directly with the Board regarding this stipulation and
17 surrender, without notice to or participation by Respondent. By signing the stipulation,
18 Respondent understands and agrees that he may not withdraw his agreement or seek to rescind the
19 stipulation prior to the time the Board considers and acts upon it. If the Board fails to adopt this
20 stipulation as its Decision and Order, the Stipulated Surrender and Disciplinary Order shall be of
21 no force or effect, except for this paragraph, it shall be inadmissible in any legal action between
22 the parties, and the Board shall not be disqualified from further action by having considered this
23 matter.

24 13. The parties understand and agree that electronic or facsimile copies of this Stipulated
25 Surrender of License and Order, including electronic or facsimile signatures thereto, shall have
26 the same force and effect as the originals.

27 14. This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order is intended by the parties to be an
28 integrated writing representing the complete, final, and exclusive embodiment of their agreement.

1 It supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous agreements, understandings, discussions,
2 negotiations, and commitments (written or oral). This Stipulated Surrender of License and Order
3 may not be altered, amended, modified, supplemented, or otherwise changed except by a writing
4 executed by an authorized representative of each of the parties.

5 15. In consideration of the foregoing admissions and stipulations, the parties agree that
6 the Board may, without further notice or formal proceeding, issue and enter the following Order:

7 **ORDER**

8 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Field Representative's License No. FR 45160, and
9 Applicator License No. RA 48306 issued to Respondent Jason L. Bohannon, are surrendered and
10 accepted by the Structural Pest Control Board.

11 1. The surrender of Respondent's Field Representative's License and Applicator License
12 and the acceptance of the surrendered license by the Board shall constitute the imposition of
13 discipline against Respondent. This stipulation constitutes a record of the discipline and shall
14 become a part of Respondent's license history with the Structural Pest Control Board.

15 2. Respondent shall lose all rights and privileges as a Field Representative and
16 Applicator in California as of the effective date of the Board's Decision and Order.

17 3. Respondent shall cause to be delivered to the Board his Field Representative's and
18 Applicator pocket licenses and, if one was issued, his wall certificates on or before the effective
19 date of the Decision and Order.

20 4. If Respondent ever files an application for licensure or a petition for reinstatement
21 with the Board or any successor agency in the State of California, the Board shall treat it as a
22 petition for reinstatement. Respondent must comply with all the laws, regulations and procedures
23 for reinstatement of a revoked license in effect at the time the petition is filed, and all of the
24 charges and allegations contained in First Amended Accusation No. 2011-72(b) shall be deemed
25 to be true, correct and admitted by Respondent when the Board determines whether to grant or
26 deny the petition.

27 5. Respondent shall pay the agency its costs of investigation and enforcement in the
28 amount of \$500.00 prior to issuance of a new or reinstated license.

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ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Stipulated Surrender of License and Order. I understand the stipulation and the effect it will have on my Field Representative's License, and Applicator License. I enter into this Stipulated Surrender of License and Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Decision and Order of the Structural Pest Control Board.


