Executive Officer of the Structural Pest Control Board ("Board"), Department of Pesticide 21 22 Regulation. On or about April 30, 2010, the Board issued Applicator License Number RA 50864 23 2. to Martin C. Aguinaga ("Respondent"). The license was in full force and effect at all times 24 relevant to the charges brought herein and will expire on April 30, 2013, unless renewed. 25 STATUTORY PROVISIONS 26 Business and Professions Code ("Code") section 8620 provides, in pertinent part, that 27 3. the Board may suspend or revoke a license when it finds that the holder, while a licensee or 28 1

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applicant, has committed any acts or omissions constituting cause for disciplinary action or in lieu 1 of a suspension may assess a civil penalty. 2 Code section 8654 states: 4. 3 Any individual who has been denied a license for any of the reasons specified 4 in Section 8568, or who has had his or her license revoked, or whose license is under suspension, or who has failed to renew his or her license while it was under 5 suspension, or who has been a member, officer, director, associate, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of any partnership, corporation, firm, or 6 association whose application for a company registration has been denied for any of the reasons specified in Section 8568, or whose company registration has been 7 revoked as a result of disciplinary action, or whose company registration is under suspension, and while acting as such member, officer, director, associate, qualifying 8 manager, or responsible managing employee had knowledge of or participated in any of the prohibited acts for which the license or registration was denied, suspended or 9 revoked, shall be prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager, or responsible managing employee of a registered company, and 10the employment, election or association of such person by a registered company is a 11 ground for disciplinary action. Code section 8625 states: 5. 12 The lapsing or suspension of a license or company registration by operation of 13 law or by order or decision of the board or a court of law, or the voluntary surrender of a license or company registration shall not deprive the board of jurisdiction to 14 proceed with any investigation of or action or disciplinary proceeding against such licensee or company, or to render a decision suspending or revoking such license or 15 registration. 16 Code section 8641 states: 6. 17 Failure to comply with the provisions of this chapter, or any rule or regulation adopted by the board, or the furnishing of a report of inspection without the making 18 of a bona fide inspection of the premises for wood-destroying pests or organisms, or furnishing a notice of work completed prior to the completion of the work specified in 19 the contract, is a ground for disciplinary action. 20 Code section 8651 states: 7. 21 The performing or soliciting of structural pest control work, the inspecting for structural or household pests, or the applying of any pesticide, chemical, or allied 22 substance for the purpose of eliminating, exterminating, controlling, or preventing structural pests in branches of pest control other than those for which the operator, 23 field representative, or applicator is licensed or the company is registered is a ground 24 for disciplinary action. 25 COST RECOVERY Code section 125.3 provides, in pertinent part, that the Board may request the 8. 26 administrative law judge to direct a licentiate found to have committed a violation or violations of 27 28 2

1	the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and
2	enforcement of the case.
3	CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINE
4	(Unlicensed Activity)
5	9. Respondent's applicator license is subject to discipline under Code section 8651, in
6	that in 2010, Respondent engaged in pest control work in a branch other than that for which he
7	was licensed.
8	OTHER MATTERS
9	10. Code section 8620 provides, in pertinent part, that a respondent may request that a
10	civil penalty of not more than \$5,000 be assessed in lieu of an actual suspension of 1 to 19 days,
11	or not more than \$10,000 for an actual suspension of 20 to 45 days. Such request must be made
12	at the time of the hearing and must be noted in the proposed decision. The proposed decision
13	shall not provide that a civil penalty shall be imposed in lieu of a suspension.
14	11. Pursuant to Code section 8654, if discipline is imposed on Applicator License No.
15	RA 50864, issued to Respondent, then Respondent shall be prohibited from serving as an officer,
16	director, associate, partner or responsible managing employee of a registered company, and any
17	licensee which employs, elects, or associates Respondent shall be subject to disciplinary action.
18	PRAYER
19	WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein
20	alleged, and that following the hearing, the Structural Pest Control Board issue a decision:
21	1. Revoking or suspending Applicator License Number RA 50864, issued to Martin C.
22	Aguinaga;
23 <sup>-</sup>	2. Revoking or suspending any other license for which Martin C. Aguinaga is furnishing
24	the qualifying experience or appearance;
25	3. Prohibiting Martin C. Aguinaga from serving as an officer, director, associate,
26	partner, qualifying manager or responsible managing employee of any registered company during
27	the period that discipline is imposed on Applicator License Number RA 50864, issued to Martin
28	C. Aguinaga;
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Ordering Martin C. Aguinaga to pay the Structural Pest Control Board the reasonable 4. costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and Professions Code section 125.3; and, Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper. 5.
