18 Complainant alleges:

19 PARTIES

20 1. Susan Saylor (Complainant) brings this Accusation solely in her official capacity as
21 the Interim Registrar/Executive Officer of the Structural Pest Control Board, Department of
22 Pesticide Regulation.

23 2. On or about May 19, 2011, the Structural Pest Control Board issued Applicator
24 License Number RA 52078, Branches 2 and 3, to Christian C. Schiefen, also known as Christian
25 Charles Schiefen (Respondent). The Applicator License was in full force and effect at all times
26 relevant to the charges brought in this Accusation and will expire on May 19, 2014, unless
27 renewed.

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1 the licensing act to pay a sum not to exceed the reasonable costs of the investigation and
2 enforcement of the case.

3 FIRST CAUSE FOR DISCIPLINARY ACTION

4 (Substantially Related Conviction)
5 (Bus. & Prof. Code §§ 8649 and 490)

6 9. Respondent has subjected his Applicator's License to disciplinary action under Code
7 sections 8649 and 490, in that he was convicted of a crime substantially related to the
8 qualifications, functions, or duties of an applicator. Specifically, on or about October 30, 2012, in
9 the Superior Court of California, County of San Francisco, Case No. 218766, entitled *The People*
10 *of the State of California v. Christian Schiefen*, Respondent pled guilty and was convicted of
11 violating Penal Code section 311.11, subdivision (a) (possession or control of child pornography),
12 a felony. The imposition of sentence was suspended and Respondent was placed on probation for
13 5 years, upon terms and conditions, which included, but were not limited to, the following: serve
14 2 days in County Jail, with credit for time served of 2 days; serve 1 year in County Jail which
15 may be served through court-ordered monitoring program; be subject to search of any and all
16 personal electronic devices; register as a sex offender for a lifetime under Penal Code 290; submit
17 a DNA sample under Penal Code 296; and obey all laws. The factual circumstances of the
18 conviction are as follows:

19 a. On or about March 19, 2012, ten San Francisco Police Department (SFPD) police
20 officers executed a search warrant at Respondent's residence located at 725 20th Avenue, San
21 Francisco, California. Respondent and his wife were present when the search warrant was
22 executed. Child pornography was found in Respondent's residence. Respondent loudly said "I
23 didn't do it babe! I don't distribute the stuff, I've seen it, but I don't distribute it. I swear!"
24 Respondent continued to protest that he did not distribute it until he was transported to a SFPD
25 station.

26 b. At the SFPD police station, Respondent told a SFPD officer that his arrest was the
27 "best thing" that could have happened to him and inquired about any counseling services that
28 could be provided to him. Respondent admitted that he uses search terms such as "Lolita," and
PTHC (Pre Teen Hard Core). Respondent admitted that looking at teenage girls as young as


1 twelve years old sexually arouses him. Respondent admitted to searching for this type of child
2 pornography, and claimed that if he ever sees "really young girls," he deletes the files because
3 that is not what he is interested in.

4 PRAYER

5 WHEREFORE, Complainant requests that a hearing be held on the matters herein alleged,
6 and that following the hearing, the Structural Pest Control Board issue a decision:

- 7 1. Revoking or suspending Applicator License Number RA 52078, issued to Christian
8 C. Schiefen;
- 9 2. Ordering Christian C. Schiefen to pay the Structural Pest Control Board the
10 reasonable costs of the investigation and enforcement of this case, pursuant to Business and
11 Professions Code section 125.3; and
- 12 3. Taking such other and further action as deemed necessary and proper.
