**STIPULATION FOR A
PROBATIONARY LICENSE**

Miguel Lopez, applicant for a structural pest control Applicator License, Branches 2 and 3 (hereinafter Applicant), and Susan Saylor, Registrar/Executive Officer, Structural Pest Control Board (Board), hereby stipulate as follows:

1. This Applicant is not presently licensed as a structural pest control applicator, field representative or operator with the Board in the State of California.
2. On or about April 20, 2016, the Structural Pest Control Board received an application for an Applicator's License Branches 2 and 3 from Miguel Lopez. Question number 14 on the license application and question number 13 on the exam application asked, in part: *"Have you ever been convicted of, or pled guilty or nolo contendere to ANY offense in the United States or a foreign country? This includes every citation, infraction, misdemeanor and/or felony, including traffic violations."* The Applicant checked the box marked "No" next to question numbers 14 and 13. On or about April 13, 2016, Applicant certified under penalty of perjury to the truthfulness of all statements, answers, and representations in the application.
3. Applicant was convicted on or about June 19, 2002, in Whittier Superior Court of Vehicle Code Section 12500(A); driving without a license.
4. Applicant was convicted on or about August 22, 2005, in Bellflower Superior Court of Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(A); driving while license was suspended.
5. Applicant was convicted on or about March 25, 2008, in Fullerton Superior Court of Penal Code Section 487(A); grand theft of money, labor or property. Applicant was sentenced to 60 days in jail, restitution and 3 years informal probation.
6. Applicant was convicted on or about October 22, 2008, in Bellflower Superior Court of Vehicle Code Section 14601.1(A); driving while license was suspended.
7. Applicant was convicted on or about August 26, 2009, in Los Angeles Superior Court of Penal Code 166(A)(4); contempt:disobey court order, etc.

ORDER


Applicant, Miguel Lopez is hereby granted a probationary Applicator's License Branches 2 and 3. However, the license shall be immediately revoked; the order of revocation shall be stayed and is placed on probation for a period of three (3) years upon the following terms and conditions:

1. **Obey All Laws.** Applicant shall obey all Federal, State and Local laws and all laws and rules relating to the practice of structural pest control.
2. **Quarterly Reports.** Applicant shall file quarterly reports with the Board during the period of probation.
3. **Tolling of Probation.** Should Applicant leave California to reside outside this state, Applicant must notify the Board in writing of the dates of departure and return. Periods of residency or practice outside the state shall not apply to reduction of the probationary period.
4. **Notice to Employers.** Applicant shall notify all present and prospective employers of the terms, conditions and restrictions imposed on Applicant by said Order. Within 30 days of the effective date of this Order, and within 15 days of Applicant undertaking new employment, Applicant shall cause his employer to report to the Board in writing acknowledging the employer has read the Order in this matter.
5. **Completion of Probation.** Upon successful completion of probation, Applicant's license will become fully restored.
6. **Violation of Probation.** Should Applicant violate probation in any respect, the Board, after giving Applicant notice and an opportunity to be heard, may revoke the probationary license.
7. **Correspondence Course.** Applicant shall complete within six (6) months of the effective date of this Order, four (4) hours of a Board approved business ethics course. These hours cannot be used towards renewal of license.
8. **Prohibited from Serving as Officer, Director, Associate, Partner or Qualifying Manager.** Applicant is prohibited from serving as an officer, director, associate, partner, qualifying manager or branch office manager of any registered company, during the period that probation is imposed on the license.
9. **Additional License.** Should Applicant apply for any additional license during probation, the Board shall issue the license, which shall be immediately, revoked, stayed and placed on probation for the same duration and under the same terms and conditions as set forth in this Order.

ACCEPTANCE

I have carefully read the Order. I understand the Order and the effect it will have on my Applicator's license. I enter into this Order voluntarily, knowingly, and intelligently, and agree to be bound by the Order of the Board.
